

Collecting the Samples, Boxes and Original Catalogs of the Manufacturers & Distributors of “Clay” or Composition Gaming Checks and Chips (and the information they yield)

In the more than 46 years that I have collected gaming checks, few collections have been as difficult to complete and yet have provided as much information about the history of gaming checks as the challenge of finding manufacturer's catalogs, boxes and chip samples. With around 100 known clay mold designs, it would seem that collecting one of each would be a snap. After starting in 1965 and giving considerable time, money and effort to the collection, I am still looking for samples and still learning about what exists.

The composition or “clay” gaming chips that we now know came into use before the turn of the 20th century. A number of companies manufactured and distributed poker chips to the general public and offered a variety of generic designs. Custom chips were fairly rare and were mostly produced for the wealthy. The United States Playing Card Company (USPC) offered some of the first customized clay chips around 1911. The company records include a number of sample books that start with custom orders of a plain mold inlaid chip. USPC records have a Hunt & Co. “chain mold” sample and a note “September 1927” in the record books. This would indicate that Hunt & Co. possibly produced the first chip that had a “mold” design embossed into the chip.

In September of 1928 USPC records have 9 color samples of a Hub” mold that was owned by Mason & Co. of Chicago, Illinois. On February 26, 1929, USPC made raised circle mold chip for A. Ball & Bro. of Chicago. A color set of 9 colors in the three ball mold was made in May of 1929 for Joe Trebal of Chicago. On November 27, 1929 a color set of 9 colors in a large crown mold was produced for T.R. King & Co. of Kansas City, Mo. The next mold in the USPC records was the diamond mold for Jack Todd with 9 color samples. On October 16, 1934 the first small Grecian key mold samples were made for B.C. Wills of Detroit. On September 28, 1938 USPC records show a large crown molded chip made for T.R. King in Los Angeles, CA.

Manufacturers vs. Distributors

Starting in the 1920's, a number of gaming equipment suppliers began to offer custom gaming chips. Rather than invest in the production facilities for chip manufacturing, these suppliers developed a relationship with the United States Playing Card Company in which they could order custom chips that were made on a “registered” mold design that only they had the right to sell. As the number of suppliers increased, new and different mold designs were introduced. In several instances, when a supplier went out of business, his mold would become an “open” mold that was available to suppliers that did not want to invest in the considerable cost of a “registered” design.

The result of this agreement was that different suppliers could offer their “registered molds” to their customers and guarantee that they would be protected against outsiders producing their chips. Although the vast majority of the chips offered were produced in the same manufacturing facility (USPC and Burt Co.), this arrangement allowed each supplier to tout his chips as the best. The manufacturers tended to only sell to the distributors who had the rights to the mold and would not sell directly to any of the distributor's customers. This two tiered system gave the manufacturers a certain amount of protection from problems with customers who might seek to subvert their competition with “counterfeit chips” and provided the distributors with the necessary security of production.

The Primary Manufacturers

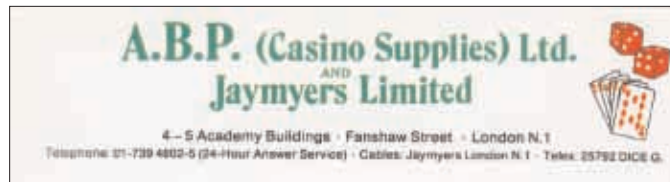
During most of the 20th century, only a hand full of companies actually manufactured custom gaming chips for casino operations. The first and oldest was United States Playing Card Company of Cincinnati, Ohio. The Burt Company of Portland, Maine also produced chips in the early part of the century, but primarily produced generic chips. Around the mid-1940's (probably 1946) the entire chip operation of the USPC was purchased by the Burt Co. who then became the largest producer of custom casino chips in the United States.

Hunt & Co. of Chicago, Illinois probably began molding chips in the 1920's under the ownership of E. M. Stockton who started the company in the late 1890's. Using hand plate molds and a steam press, Hunt & Co. produced the "Chain Mold" chips in several variations.

T.R. King & Co. began manufacturing casino chips in Los Angeles, CA after moving from Kansas City in 1931. T.R. King acted as a distributor for their chips.

The Paulson Company of Las Vegas, Nevada was established in 1966 and began their own manufacture of custom casino chips in the 1970's after initially using the Burt Company.

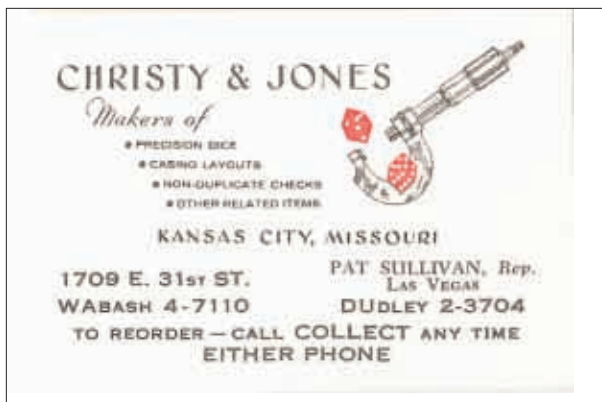


Originally Christy & Garrett, the company was renamed when William Chiristy & Bernard (Bud) Jones each purchased a 50% interest. They operated out of Kansas City, Missouri with a representative in Las Vegas. In the early 1960's Christy & Jones purchased the Jack Todd company from Todd's widow and thus gained the use of the Todd diamond mold along with their Hat & Cane mold. Bowing to pressure from national investigations into gambling by the McCellan committee of the U.S. Senate, both Christy and Jones decided that it was better to move to Las Vegas than starve in Kansas City. They moved the company to Las Vegas in October of 1963.

All of the Christy & Jones production was made for them by the Burt Company in Portland, Maine.



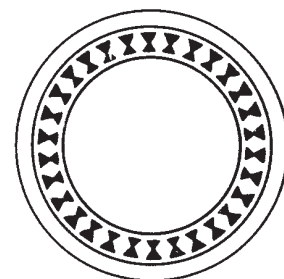
Pat Sullivan, their Las Vegas manager, originally had no stake in the company, but after lobbying for some ownership, Bill Christy and Bud Jones agreed to each give Sullivan, their manager a small stake in the company. Once the papers for the stock transfer were signed, Christy and Sullivan called a stock holders meeting and voted Bud Jones out of the Company at the end of 1964. Shocked and angered by the move, Bud Jones was forced to rely on a few friends (pit bosses) who gave him some dice orders. Starting the Bud Jones company in his garage, Bud eventually expanded into a full line gaming supplier.

Bill Christy and Pat Sullivan played down the removal of Jones from the company. Sullivan had lobbied both Jones and Christy to make "special" dice and with Jones out of the picture, they could proceed. In October of 1965, the ax fell on Christy and Sullivan when federal agents raided Bill Christy's home and found "crooked dice" that the company had shipped to Mississippi. With the original company gone, Pat Sullivan developed his own company under his name.
