

# Sorting Out Harrah's

A recent discovery in the Nevada Club warehouse by Ron Gillio has produced a clarification of some of Harrah's early gaming check issues. A group of intertwined key chains that was apparently used by the cashier's cage at the Nevada Club to help cashiers sort out the chips of neighboring Harrah's Club also clarifies some of Harrah's issues. Combined with photographs from the files of Central Credit for chip identification, Harrah's multiple issues can be sorted into three of Harrah's separate operations. During this period of time, Central Credit lists 4 separate locations for Harrah's chips - Harrah's (Reno) - Harrah's Restaurant (Reno) - Harrah's Tahoe - Harrah's Stateline (west side of highway 50). Chips for Harrah's Restaurant had a Hat & Cane mold while the other three locations all used B.C. Wills small Grecian key checks.
